FasTrax Clean Room Doors from **Rite Hite Doors** (Milwaukee, WI) feature a one-piece radial header, which is machined from a solid block of UHMW plastic. It meets both USDA and FDA standards for clean-up. The door's fabric is a smooth polypropylene, which provides higher resistance to acids and bases and a lower water absorption rate than vinyls and urethanes. This fabric makes it resistant to mold and gives it superior washdown qualities, even with harsh cleaning chemicals, says the company. The roll-up design of FasTrax doors allows them to operate at speeds of 100 inches per second, minimizing air intrusion while maximizing productivity. These high operating speeds also decrease the likelihood of forklift collisions. However, if impacted, a FasTrax door can reconfigure itself to get back onto the door track.
